

CONSENT

for the processing of personal data of the author of a scientific publication by the mass media "Journal of Biomedical Photonics & Engineering"

make the decision to provide my personal data and give consent to their processing freely, voluntarily, and in my own interests in accordance with Part 4 of Article 9 of the Federal Law of the Russian Federation No. 152-FZ of July 27, 2006, "On Personal Data", to the publisher of the journal - Samara National Research University, legal address: 34, Moskovskoe shosse, Samara, 443086 (hereinafter referred to as "university").

The purpose of processing personal data is to disseminate scientific knowledge in the scientific information space through the Journal of Biomedical Photonics & Engineering (<https://jbpe.ssau.ru>), in accordance with the Law of the Russian Federation No. 2124-1 dated December 27, 1991, "On Mass Media".

The list of personal data for which consent is given: last name, first name, middle name (if any); gender; mailing address; academic degree, academic title; affiliation, position; phone number, e-mail address; title of the author's publication, identifiers (ORCID, elibrary SPIN-code, Scopus Author ID, ResearcherID), including personal data specified in the registration form on the website of the online publication and in the license agreement.

The list of actions with personal data for which consent is given: review of submissions/publications; conclusion of license agreements with authors, implementation of the provisions of such agreements throughout their validity; organization of document management and record-keeping in the operator's office for license agreements concluded with the authors, obtaining consents to the processing of personal data, agreements for the processing of other documents; preparation and posting metadata of the journal's publication, including title of articles, annotations and author's keywords, information about the source of publication, output data, information about the authors using identifiers; preparation and posting electronic versions of articles and online editions in PDF format in free open access; creation of archives of online publication issues and placing them in the public domain; the formation of the operator's library collections, provision of online editions for national and foreign libraries, providing access to scientific information and exposure to the values of national and world culture; the provision of online editions to national and international abstract databases and citation systems, including the National Library of Sciences eLibrary (RSCI), RNJ, RCNI, Crossref, Scopus, Chemical Abstracts Service.

The above actions (functions) are performed by collecting, recording, systematizing, accumulating, storing, clarifying (updating, changing), extracting, using, transferring, blocking, deleting, destroying personal data using paper and electronic media or through communication channels in compliance with measures to protect them from unauthorized access.

General description of the methods of personal data processing used by the operator: the university has the right to carry out mixed (automated and non-automated) processing of my personal data by entering them into electronic databases, including them in lists (registers) and reporting forms provided for in documents regulating the provision of reporting data (documents).

Information about information resources and services that can be used for mixed and automated processing of personal data is included in Table 1.

In accordance with Federal Law No. 127-FZ of August 23, 1996 "On Science and State Scientific and Technological Policy" and in order to ensure the freedom of access to scientific and scientific and technical information, cross-border data transfers are carried out to international abstract databases and citation systems.

After the publication of the next issue of the journal, the author's article is included in its archive.

The storage and processing of archival issues is carried out in accordance with Paragraph 2 of Part 1.1 Article 1 of Federal Law of the Russian Federation No. 152-FZ dated July 27, 2006, "On Personal Data," in accordance with legislation on archiving.

The data contained in the license agreement concluded with the author is stored in accordance with the requirements provided for the organization of record keeping contained in the regulatory legal acts of authorized federal government bodies in the field of archival affairs and record keeping, as well as the federal government body performing the functions of the founder of the operator.

The period of validity of the consent to the processing of personal data. This consent is valid from the moment of its signing until the expiration of the university's right to use the author's publication, or the validity of the license agreement, or until its revocation. The consent may be revoked at any time upon a written application sent to the university by registered mail with a notification of delivery or submitted to an authorized representative of the university under a signature indicating the date of receipt.

I have been notified that if my written application for revocation of this consent to the processing of personal data is received, the university has the right to continue processing my personal data for the period and to the extent prescribed by law, or to refuse to process my personal data if further processing is not possible in accordance with the procedure established by law, regulated by international and national rules applied by the editorial, publishing, and author community.
